	have been declared. He has filed affidavit of Shri. Vyankatesh Ramesh

On perusal of affidavit filed by the Respondent No.1, *prima facie* shows that financial arrangement is being made by the Municipal Council for sanitation, construction of road and other works. We, however, could not locate from the affidavit as to how the work of establishment of STP and the sewerage system, as well as solid Waste Management, is being executed and what plan is designed for this purpose.

From the record, it appears *prima facie* that Sewage is being discharged in the river without any treatment and as such, pollution of water, contamination of water is rather undisputed by MPCB, and appears to be also clear on account of reports of water quality. The downstream water of river appears to be polluted and possibility of it reaching in such a condition upto Nazari dam. It further appears that water available to citizens of township like Jejuri etc. is not of desirable quality.

Considering aggravated health problem due to contaminated pollution of drinking water, it is urgently required that Saswad Municipal Council, shall be eligible to establish STP and manage MSW effectively. The Municipal Council, is therefore, directed to seek permission from Election Commission (EC), so required to immediately issue the work order by taking all the necessary steps for the purpose. In fact, the Respondent No.1 - Municipal Council, has not placed on record any material to show such prohibition is imposed to go ahead with the work for establishment of STP. This aspect may
